Farm Dog Certification Tests – Open to All Breeds

The AKC Farm Dog Certified (FDC) Test is open to all dogs at least 9 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, or neutered dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program.

- Females in season may not participate.
- Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to enter provided, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the entire course.

Entries are Open. Pre-Entries Close: 6:00 pm on March 19, 2026

After this time, pre-entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Regulations for Herding Tests and Trials.

FDC Entries Limited to 20 runs per event.

Day of entries will be accepted if maximum limit is not reached at closing.

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ENTRY INFORMATION – FARM DOG TEST

ENTRY FEES: Pre-entries: \$20/per dog/per run, includes AKC \$3.50 recording fee.
Make checks payable to Hat Trick Caos. **ADD \$2/entry for MAIL IN**

Day-of-entries: \$25/per dog/per run, Cash or Paypal only.

Day of entries will be taken until 8:00 AM provided there is space available in either test.

Please note it takes two test passes to earn the title, so cost is per test.

Confirmations and judging schedule will be sent by e-mail only.

- If sending entries overnight, make sure to sign waiver that allows the delivery person to leave packages without a signature. Requiring a signature will only delay receipt of your entries.
- Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry and will be subject to a \$35 collection fee.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print clearly and carefully the information on entry forms to eliminate errors. The Trial Secretary is not responsible for illegible (in the opinion of the Trial Sec) entry form information.
- Entries may be declined and dogs may be removed on any account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against any group or any official.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered test, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the Test, no refund will be made.
- When entry limits are reached, all additional entries received prior to closing will be added to an alternates list in the order entry was received. The alternates list will be used to fill vacancies that occur, with the first alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the event entered.
- A signed Consent and Release from Liability form must accompany each entry.

PRIZES: Each dog passing a Farm Dog Certification Test receive a dark green ribbon

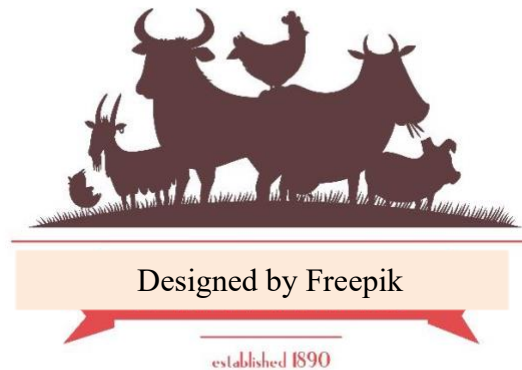
Rosettes are available for new titles.



TITLES: Dogs that pass Farm Dog Certification Tests under two different judges are eligible for a Farm Dog Certified Title. An application form for the title is included at the end of the premium list for the convenience of exhibitors. Owners will need to complete the application form and send it and the appropriate fee to the American Kennel Club;

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION: Handler Meeting – 9:00 AM

- **Check in will begin at 8:00 AM.**
 - Tests will begin after Handler's meeting.
 - Dogs must wear a secure, well-fitting, flat collar during the test evaluation and be held on a proper fixed-length leash at all times while on the farm site unless confined in a crate, kennel or vehicle. The leash shall be four to six feet in length. No prong or electronic collars, head halters, harnesses or flexi-leads are permitted on the premises.
 - NO FLEXI-TYPE RETRACTABLE LEASHES ALLOWED on site.
 - You are responsible for picking up after your dogs and disposing of waste in the proper receptacles. A failure to do so could result in you and your dog being dismissed from the trial grounds and be barred from competing.
 - Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting herding stock nor to interfere outside the testing area with another dog's performance in the test areas. The Judge may request the removal of any dog from the immediate test area at any time, if she determines the presence of the dog presents a risk to livestock, other dogs or persons on the farm.
 - Un-entered dogs are NOT allowed in the test/trial areas.
 - Entered Dogs allowed in the test area and areas designated for pottying dogs.
 - Bitches in season may not enter.
 - No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same judge at any Test.
 - Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor the Course Director will be responsible or obligated to furnish any services for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging.
 - The Groups sponsoring these events, the course director, their agents, officers, club members and committee members shall assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for injury to you, children or dogs.
- YOU ENTER AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- All dogs must have current vaccinations for rabies, distemper, parvo
 - Children must be accompanied by and kept under the direct supervision of an adult at all times.
 - Please follow parking directions.
 - Please vacate the premises upon completion of the tests.
 - Bring your own chair and shade and water for your dogs. Dress appropriately for the weather.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies,

I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. I (we) will pay for any injuries or the replacement value in this event of serious injury to the livestock caused by my (our) dog. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us). FARM DOG CERTIFIED TITLE APPLICATION

If a dog passes the Farm Dog Certified Test on two occasions under two different judges, the owner may apply for the suffix Farm Dog Certified (FDC) title by submitting this title application form. Applying for the title is up to the discretion of the owner. To apply an owner must submit this completed form along with a \$30.00 fee. Upon verification, the title will be recorded on a dog's record, a title certificate issued and the title will appear on a dog's pedigree. Please be aware that event superintendents / secretaries may, but are not required to, include the FDC title in event catalogs. Please note that the date appearing on the title certificate will be the most recent date listed below.
