****There will be a \$30 fee assessed for any returned checks (insufficient funds).**

No cancellation refunded after the closing date. All cancellations are subject to a \$1.50 processing fee and \$3.50 AKC recording fee. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned/Re-deposited checks do not constitute a valid entry.



“FUN RUNS” (PRACTICE RUNS) \$5.00 each at the conclusion of official Trial runs.

Designated times for fun runs will be determined after pre-entry closes.

Time Blocks: Entry forms will have the option of signing up for a particular time slot. Entries will be acknowledged by email. We will try our best to honor the time you select, but we may have to shuffle some entries to accommodate everyone.

People are to arrive and leave according to their assigned time slots. You may come 30 minutes early to walk your dogs and be ready to run. Staff will call out and post when we're ready to start the next hour, which is when you can get in line for the check-in. Have your catcher/releaser ready when you get in line. Do not expect Club members to be available to assist with catching or releasing.

Check-in is followed by inspection for fitness, lameness, and “in season” females. **DOGS MUST BE INSPECTED BEFORE EACH RUN.** Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded. Bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded. **Please do not bring bitches in season to the test.**

TEST HOURS: Friday, Saturday & Sunday 9am-4pm Check-in closes at 3:00pm. Worker dogs run from 9-10am
A lunch break will be taken each day at approximately noon.

Fast CAT will be divided into one-hour time blocks with concurrent tests. We will do our best to accommodate requests, but preferred time blocks are not guaranteed. If all blocks fill, more time slots may be added to accommodate additional entries. Workers/volunteers may run their dogs prior to the first morning block, or their dogs may be added in during the day.

AWARDS: Flat ribbons will be provided for qualifying runs and fun runs. Rosettes will be provided for new BCAT, DCAT and FCAT titles. If your dog is expected to earn a title at this event, please let us know.

Conditions of Entry:

Dogs may only run once per test. Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program.

SCHEDULE:

Workers dogs are from 9:00am – 10:00am, then dogs with assigned times will begin. There will be no exhibitor briefing. There will be a lunch break for the staff at midday.

COVID: We will be in compliance with CDC, state and county COVID19 requirements, which may change before the event. The HTC facility requires masks to be worn by anyone not fully vaccinated. Please do not come if you are feeling ill or if you had a recent positive COVID19 test.

Food

Bottled water and packaged snacks, but no lunch, will be available. There are a variety of fast-food restaurants within 6-7 miles from the location.

What is Fast CAT?

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line. The course is completely fenced and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100- yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).

FORMULA: $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$

Based on the dog's size at the withers, a handicap is applied, and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS (ROUNDED TO NEAREST 0.01)}$

Titles

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

- BCAT = 150 points
- DCAT = 500 points
- FCAT = 1,000 points
- FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

Top 20 by Breed by Year:

The AKC Fast CAT website will feature the Top 20 Fastest Dogs by Breed by Year national standings. The standings will be updated as event results are processed at https://www.apps.akc.org/apps/fastcat_ranking

YAC & HTC Trial Information:

- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK
- Dogs may run with a flat collar. No harnesses, clothes, or other types of collars are allowed.
- No toys or treats may be used to encourage your dog before it crosses the finish line. No whistles or other noise devices may be used.
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Bring your own shade, chairs and water.
- Owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. No exceptions. Red buckets will be available for waste disposal.

- Keep well away from the FAST CAT course when not entering or leaving the course. This is for the protection of your dog and also to avoid distracting dogs running the course.
- The show grounds are fenced. The Fast CAT course will be fenced.
- A portable toilet will be on site.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- A \$5 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s).
- Each dog requires an entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded minus processing fees.
- The Hunt master is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, may be disciplined by the AKC, and entry fees will not be refunded.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.
- Youngsville Agility Club and Hat Trick Chaos members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.
